Code of Conduct

When organising and planning your Parade group, please consider the diversity of the community and audience at the event. People will take part for many reasons. These include: to have fun, to show their support for the LGBT community, to promote their business or group and many more!

It's important that you have a visual identity to showcase your group, organisation or business so you don't get lost in the crowd, the more creative the better!

Chester Pride respects everyone's right to express themselves as they choose. Please keep in mind there will be children at the event so we ask that you take this into consideration. We will not tolerate homophobia, transphobia or any intolerance towards others.

Our main aim for any Parade group is to enjoy the Parade and have fun.

Parade Guidelines

- 1] We ask that you follow all instructions given by our Stewards and Chester Pride Committee members.
- 2] There is no alcohol to be consumed by any Parade group during the Parade.
- 3] No objects are to be thrown at spectators along the Parade route. This includes the use of silly string, party poppers and water pistols.
- 4] Please ensure your group is keeping the orderly flow of the Parade.
- 5] Please do not collect donations during the Parade.
- 6] If you are considering playing music during the Parade, please specify this on the application form.

The Chester Pride Committee has:-

- 1] The right to refuse any application including those we consider to be a health and safety hazard. If you have any concerns about your entry, please contact us to discuss.
- 2] The right to dismiss any group at the event that do not follow the guidelines listed above.
- 3] The right to dismiss any group that have entered under a false name or given false information. If you need to make any changes to your application please contact us in advance.
- 4] Finality of all decisions.
